Subject: Mandatory entering, via the Fasah platform, of information related to empty containers

With reference to the Saudi Customs circular No. 184-41-081035, dated (10/24/1441 AH), indicating the development of customs business in all its aspects and the automation of operations through the Fasah platform, so as to reduce paper-based dealings with maritime agents regarding the receipt and entry of empty containers, including ensuring that all customs departments at sea ports shall not receive any paper requests from maritime agents regarding the receipt and entry of containers after Sunday 07/11/1441 AH, corresponding to 6/28/2020. Requests shall be received only through the container closure permit service (attached).

To approve and take the necessary measures to start implementing these procedures, each within its own jurisdiction.
