Subject: The list of companies whose new vehicles are temporarily banned from entering the Kingdom

Following the Saudi Ports Authority circular No. (58) of 2020, which reference the Saudi Standards, Metrology and Quality Org. letter on temporarily banning entry of new vehicles from companies that did not submit supply plan for 2020 until they submit the supply plan by the end of this year.

We wish to note that the letter issued by the Saudi Standards, Metrology and Quality Org. No. 488 dated 29/01/1442H which includes this temporary ban is for light duty vehicles which do not exceed 3.5 tons and imported from the specified companies on the E-portal of the Energy Efficiency ([www.sls.gov.sa](http://www.sls.gov.sa)), while making sure to follow the updates mentioned, as the list is updated based on the companies compliance to submitting their supply plan to the Saudi Standards, Metrology and Quality Org.
