Subject: related to ensuring the issuance of bills through SADAD payment system

Reference to the Saudi Ports Authority' circular No. (59) of 2020, related to implementing the use of the unified system for payment and to not use cash transactions for payment and refund, using the instant electronic payment and collection methods approved in the Kingdom by issuing bills through SADAD payment system, and to use the available channels whether through Saudi Payments or Tabadul (Fasah Pay)

The Saudi Ports Authority stresses on shipping agents to comply with issuing all the bills affiliated with the owners of cargo and shipments and the concerned entities through SADAD payment system and to not issue any bill not linked to SADAD system.

As the Saudi Ports Authority will conduct inspection tours to ensure the implementation of the aforementioned, and taking regulatory procedures on non-compliant which can result in suspending the engagement of activities.
