Subject: Related to Advanced Cargo Information Declaration (ACID) system at Egyptian ports and the consequent delay in truck drivers' departure in the port for several days until they obtain approval to enter the Arab Republic of Egypt, and requesting shipping agents to facilitate the departure of delayed drivers.

Reference to the General Directorate of Passports' telegram No. 2655 dated 29/3/1443H sent to the Saudi Ports Authority which include the noticeable delay in truck drivers' departure (transit-delivery of goods) whose trucks are carrying goods exported to the Arab Republic of Egypt as they are not provided with tickets booking and issuing from the shipping agent until they are registered in a platform dedicated to Egyptian ports and granted the approval of entry to the Arab Republic of Egypt through this platform which result in expiry of their visas before they obtain the approval, and their request to stress on shipping agents to start registering the trucks in the platform dedicated to Egyptian ports and approve their entry prior to truck entering the port.

Therefore, the Saudi Ports Authority stresses on the necessity of registering trucks in platform dedicated to Egyptian ports and approve truck entry prior to entering the port.
